- 1) **Respect game officials, abide by park rules, and understand the sanctioned rules for youth sports league and local athletic guidelines. Report infraction of the rules immediately to city staff, game officials, head coach or assistant, or a designated parent age group representative.**
- 2) **No smoking or alcohol. Use of these products within the Sports complex is prohibited. Smokers must use designated areas or stay at least 50 feet from team dugouts, public bleachers, building entrances, or concessions.**
- 3) **Keep all recreational facilities (i.e. dugouts, batting cages, fields, gym, basketball and tennis courts) clean for next team. All trash must be properly removed and disposed of at the end of each game or designated practices.**
- 4) **No pets are allowed in the sports complex at any time for health and safety of the youth league participants and spectators.**
- 5) **Always maintain a safe environment for the players and report any accidents to staff on duty or within 24 hours by calling the office at (850)233-5045.**
- 6) **Assist with tryout to fairly rate players and build balanced teams. All coaches should attend their respective age group's final draft after tryouts.**

I understand that if I do not follow the guidelines of the City of Panama City Beach Parks & Recreation, the Athletic Division reserves the right to discontinue your rights to coach with youth programs. Repeat offenders will be asked to leave the premises immediately. Report any infraction of the rules, accidents, or incidents to the PCB Parks & Recreation Office. (850) 233-5045.
