

Park Rules



Please dispose of all trash in proper receptacles. Teams/ Coaches should help remove trash from dugouts at the conclusion of each game. Please do not throw cigarette butts and peanut shells on the ground.

Play sports tobacco free. No smoking is permitted in sports complex or aquatic center.

No personal coolers or food may be brought into sports complex (team coolers only).

No glass containers allowed in park.

No pets allowed in city parks (Ordinance #694 Sec. 5-50) except for the designated Dog Play Area and Greenways and Trails. Owners must pick up after their pets and keep leashed at all times.

Frank Brown Park Freshwater Lake is a youth fishing pond stocked by the Florida Fish & Wildlife. All fishermen must be accompanied by a child 16 years or younger. Daily limits are posted.

No alcoholic beverages allowed in sports complex.

No bicycles, skateboards, golf carts, scooters, etc. allowed in the sports complex, buildings, ball fields, picnic pavilions, tennis courts, shuffle board, or basketball courts. Greenways and Trails are paved for open recreational multi-use.

No motorized vehicles on paved Greenways and Trails (Ordinance #1009).

Outdoor tennis courts and basketball courts are available on first come, first serve basis. Tennis court lights can be turned on by players between the hours of dusk and 9 p.m.

All sport's fields must be reserved in advance through the Facilities & Special Events Supervisor (850)233-5045. Batting cages are open during normal hours of operation.

Picnic areas available on first come, first serve basis except for the Community Center Pavilion which should be reserved for groups in advance: (850)233-5045

Under the Palms Playground is designated for ages 2-14. Adult supervision is required. Proper shoes must be worn on the playground area, no cleats!
